DESIGNING OUR STAND

Here are some common items that are used at a lemonade stand to get us started. Can you think of any more?

Containers
Cups
Lemons
Spoons

SETTING THE PRICE

In order to sell lemonade, we want to calculate on how much one glass of lemonade would cost by taking each item and finding out how many glasses you can make with it.

For example: 100 cups cost \$6.17, so we want to divide \$6.17 by 100 to get a price of \$.06 per cup.

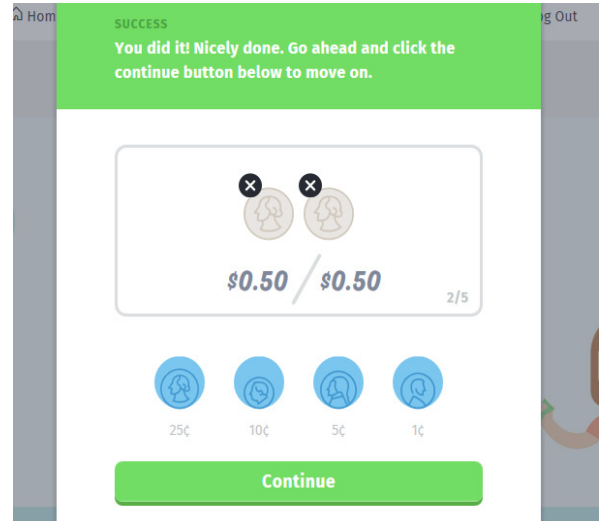
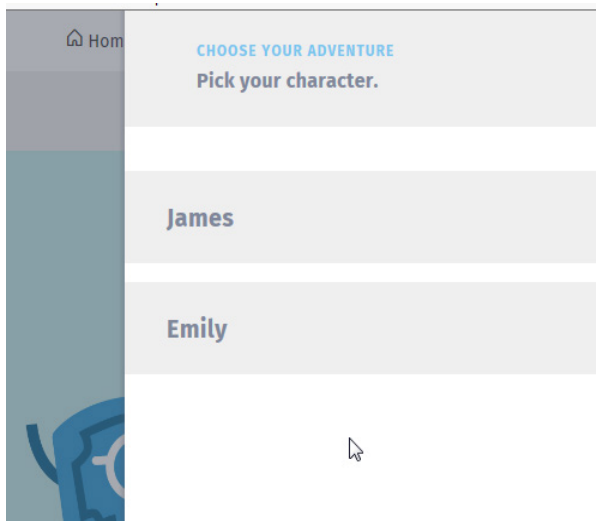

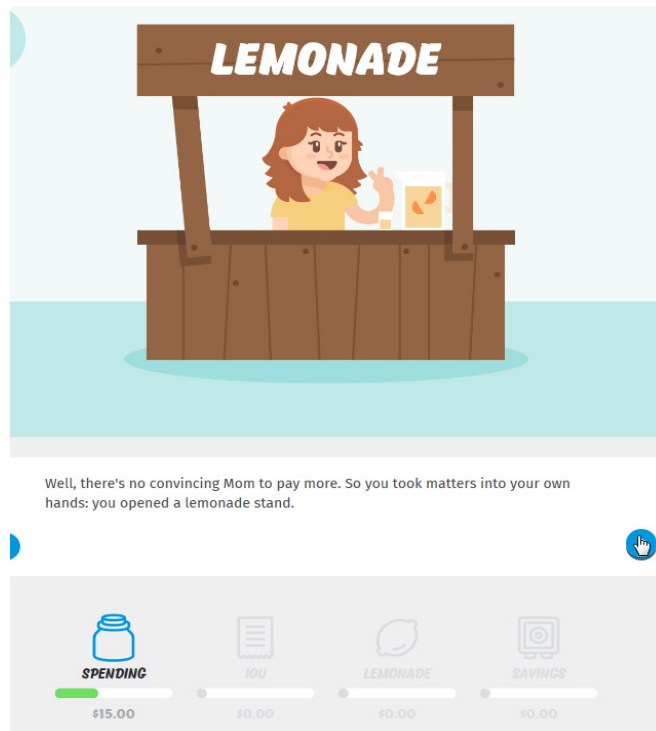
EXCITING NEWS

When starting the game you get to pick your own character as well as learning how to make change.

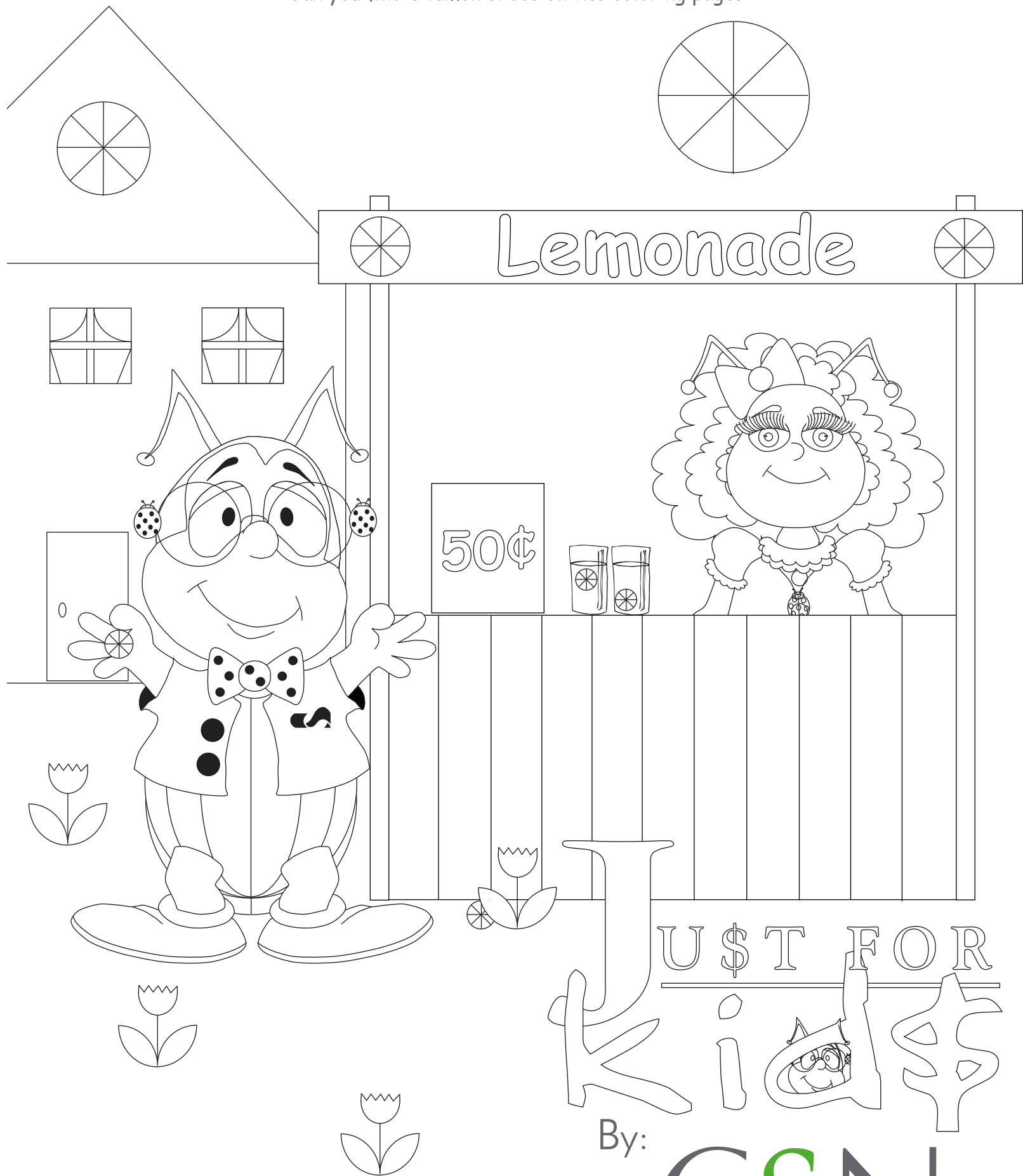


The game will show you that there can be unexpected expenses when saving and creative ways to earn money.
